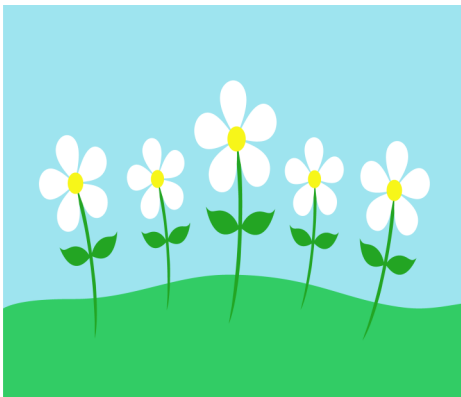

According to **The Old Farmer's Almanac**, the March equinox occurs on **Thursday, March 20, 2026**.
